In 2001, I moved to the United States, and worked as an Associate Professor with Tenure in the Radiology department, Neuroradiology section at the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center in New Orleans, Louisiana, until June 2007. The same year, I moved to my current academic position as an Assistant Professor of Radiology/Neuroradiology at Harvard Medical School, Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston, MA. My list of publications includes 134 articles as head-author or co-author, as well as eight books chapters. My research efforts have focused on MRI brain imaging, particularly in functional MRI, diffusion tensor imaging (DTI) and MR spectroscopy in brain neoplasms.
